- Working tour of the Printing Museum


PULP AND PAPER

MERIT BADGE DAY INFORMATION

FOR SCOUTS WHO HAVE REGISTERED FOR MERIT BADGE DAY,

PLEASE GO THROUGH THE STEPS BELOW TO PREPARE FOR THE MERIT BADGE DAY

Registered Scouts will need to:

- 1. Register and pay by Monday, November 28th.
- 2. Download registration packet. Scout is responsible to read through.
- 3. Download the Merit Badge books (Graphic Arts and Pulp and Paper) and read through. Link will be provided AFTER you register.
- 4. Visit the websites and YouTube videos listed in the registration packet.
- 5. Complete any projects or tasks outlined in the registration packet.
- 6. BRING at least one blank, light colored T-shirt for screen printing.
- 7. Wear class A for the car ride. Wear your class B uniform underneath your Class A. We will wear class B during this event.
- 8. Plan for Snack Shack (\$1 items) and Hot Dog Lunch (\$5 with soda and chips); you can pre-pay for either at time of check-in. You can bring your lunch and refillable water bottle.
- 9. Scouts will be provided a Parent/Guardian RELEASE FORM to complete. Provide Troop leader with Parent/Guardian RELEASE FORM. You cannot participate in the event without this form.
- 10. WHAT TO BRING Each scout should collect about 6 different samples of printing from their home to learn about, ie. book, greeting card, product package, magazine, food wrapper, etc (be creative and have fun!). One of your stations will talk about printing processes to make different printed pieces. Bring your samples in a bag to carry with you during the day. You will be sharing them during the Printing Process & Printed Products Station A.
- 11. MERIT BADGE BLUE CARD Each scout must bring their Merit Badge Blue Card for each merit badge; THEY MUST BE FILLED OUT PRIOR TO ARRIVAL with the scout, troop, merit badge info. The Merit Badge Counselor will sign and distribute the Blue Cards at the conclusion of the event at 3 pm.
